The New Mexico Health Insurance Exchange (NMHIX), also known as beWellnm, in collaboration with the New Mexico Office of Superintendent of Insurance (OSI), is releasing this 2022 Letter to Issuers participating in New Mexico’s state-based exchange for Plan Year (PY) 2022. This letter is issued alongside and incorporates guidance from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) 2022 Letter to Issuers in the Federally-facilitated Exchanges. This letter provides operational and technical guidance for the 2022 Plan Year for issuers seeking to offer qualified health plans (QHPs), including stand-alone dental plans (SADPs), on the exchange (“beWellnm Platform”).¹ It contains guidance provided by CMS and OSI to ensure compliance with the New Mexico Administrative Code (NMAC), the NM Insurance Code (§59A NMSA 1978) and the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). During the 2021 transition year, carriers should refer to this letter, as well as OSI and CMS guidance, to help them successfully participate on the beWellnm Platform in Plan Year 2022.

To the extent that this guidance summarizes policies proposed through other rulemaking processes that have not yet been finalized, such as the rulemaking process for the federal 2022 Payment Notice Proposed Rule, stakeholders should comment on those underlying policies through the ongoing rulemaking processes, not to the email address provided here. CHAPTER 1: Certification Process for Qualified Health Plans and Stand-Alone Dental Plans

The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) and applicable regulations provide that health plans, including Qualified Dental Plans, also known as Stand-Alone Dental Plans (SADPs), must meet a number of standards in order to be certified as qualified health plans (QHPs) or SADPs. Several of these are market-wide standards that apply to plans offered in the individual and small group markets, both inside and outside of the Exchanges. The remaining standards are specific to health plans seeking QHP certification from the Exchanges.

This chapter provides an overview of the QHP certification process. Additional information and instructions about the process for issuers to complete a QHP application is forthcoming and will be published on OSI's website at <https://www.osi.state.nm.us/index.php/insurers/healthcare-reform>.

Section 1. QHP Certification Process and Timeline

Issuers should submit a complete QHP application according to the timelines provided in Table 1, "Proposed QHP Data Submission and Certification Timeline for Plan Year 2022." NMHIX and OSI will review QHP applications for current and new issuers applying for QHP certification and, as needed, communicate with issuers about corrections to their submissions.

NMHIX will send Draft Plan Year 2022 Issuer Agreements for issuers to review prior to finalizing the agreements. Once finalized, NMHIX will send the Final Plan Year 2022 Issuer Agreements to QHP and SADP issuers to sign and submit to NMHIX outlined in Table 1. NMHIX will countersign the Issuer Agreements and return them to issuers. NMHIX will then publish a final list of certified QHPs and SADPs, completing the certification process for the upcoming plan year.

Issuers will submit a complete QHP application for plans they intend to have certified in New Mexico. The "Early Bird" QHP Application submission window, as defined by CMS, is an optional submission window for issuers wishing to submit application data prior to the first formal submission deadline. Issuers may also submit form and rate filings at this time.

An issuer must formally request a plan withdrawal from OSI, with copy to NMHIX, in order to withdraw a plan from QHP certification consideration, or to change an on-Exchange QHP under certification consideration to an off Exchange only plan under approval consideration. In addition to OSI notification, plan withdrawal requests should also follow the process outlined by CMS.²

Please note: All QHP binders must be certified and approved through SERFF and the beWellnm Platform's Plan Management Portal, respectively, in order for plans to be visible for purchase to consumers. Once binder submission occurs, no additional plans can be added. Also, final certification and publication on the beWellnm Platform can only occur once the QHP application is Approved-Certified by OSI. Any changes needed to a QHP or SADP binder after 8/14/2021 will require a State Authorization form to be submitted to NMHIX and approved by OSI or NMHIX, as appropriate. The form will be posted on the beWellnm website.

Please note: To ensure successful submission to CMS, which is still required during the SBE transition, some dates have been advanced from the CMS schedule. Section 2. Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) Requirements

Section 3. QHP Application Data Submission

NMHIX and OSI expect issuers to adhere to the QHP certification timeline. NMHIX requires issuers, including SADPs seeking certification, to submit complete QHP applications by the initial binder submission deadline on June 11, 2021 and to make necessary updates to the QHP application prior to the rate amendment deadline on July 18, 2021.

All issuers must obtain Health Insurance Oversight System (HIOS) product and plan IDs through HIOS. The beWellnm Platform, specifically the Plan Management Portal, is used by beWellnm and Issuers to review and verify the accuracy of plan data. Issuers applying for QHP certification will use the National Association of Insurance Commissioners' System for Electronic Rate and Form Filing (SERFF) to submit plan data, including required templates, and any other data required to demonstrate compliance with state and federal law.

All issuers applying for certification will be able to view plan data in the beWellnm Platform's Plan Management Portal – after OSI transfers the data from SERFF -- in order to identify and correct data submission errors before the rate amendment deadline on July 18, 2021. Issuers should utilize the Plan Management Portal environment to verify that their plan display reflects their approved filings and will display properly for consumers. All plans must be verified in the Plan Management Portal by August 31, 2021, as reflected in Table 1, Proposed Data Submission and Certification Timeline for Plan Year 2022. NMHIX will provide additional information to Issuers about the Plan Management Portal prior to first use, which is planned for mid-June.

Discrepancies between an issuer's submission in SERFF, HIOS and the Plan Management Portal may result in a plan not being certified or a compliance action if OSI has already certified a plan. All issuers must complete quality assurance activities to ensure the completeness and accuracy of application data, including reviewing plan data in the Plan Management Portal, and run all necessary review tools provided by CMS. Section 4. Data Changes

During the initial application submission and before the QHP submission deadline of 6/11/2021, issuers can make changes without NMHIX and OSI authorization. After the close of the initial application submission window, issuers may not add new plans to an application or change an off-Exchange plan to be both on- and off-Exchange. In addition, issuers may not change plan type(s) or market type and may not change QHPs, excluding SADPs, from a child-only plan to a non-child-only plan. Issuers can make rate amendments and update their Plans and Benefits templates during the period listed in *Table 1*.

Except for service area changes, after the rate amendment deadline, issuers can only make changes if requested and approved by both NMHIX and OSI. Prior to the final certification deadline, issuers may submit plan withdrawal requests to withdraw plans or change an on-Exchange SADP to off-Exchange.

NMHIX and OSI encourage issuers to only submit plans for QHP certification that it intends to offer to consumers. Please refer to *Table 2. Key Dates for QHP Data Changes*.

To withdraw a plan from certification consideration, an issuer must submit a formal withdrawal request to both NMHIX and OSI. After submission of an initial application, an issuer should not remove plan data from the application templates, even if the issuer withdraws a plan. In addition, issuers seeking to change an on-Exchange status under certification consideration to an off-Exchange status for approval consideration must submit a plan withdrawal request.

After completion of the OSI certification process on August 14, NMHIX may allow issuers to make changes and data corrections in order to correct data display errors on the beWellnm Platform and to align QHP display with products and plans approved by OSI. Post-certification data corrections require data change requests and NMHIX and OSI approval. NMHIX may offer additional data correction windows for approved changes.

Issuers whose applications are not accurate after the Certification deadline on August 13, 2021, and are required to make changes during the limited data correction window, may be subject to compliance action by OSI. Issuer changes made in the limited data correction window require state authorization. Changes to a QHP Application not approved by NMHIX and/or OSI, may lead to compliance action, decertification and suppression of the issuer’s plans on the beWellnm Platform.

Discrepancies between the issuer’s application and approved State filings may result in a plan not being certified or a compliance action if NMHIX and/or OSI have already certified the plan. Issuers that request to make changes that affect consumers may have their plans suppressed from display on the beWellnm Platform until the data is corrected and refreshed for consumer display.

Section 5. QHP Review Coordination with NMHIX

NMHIX, in consultation with OSI, will define the relevant submission windows for reviews as well as dates and processes for corrections and resubmissions. OSI will perform plan and rate reviews and certification, and NMHIX will conduct data validity reviews to ensure plans are presented correctly on the beWellnm Platform.

Issuers seeking certification in New Mexico should continue to refer to OSI direction in addition to this guidance. NMHIX and OSI will establish the timeline, communication process, and resubmission window for any reviews conducted under State and Federal authority. As noted previously, issuers should comply with any State-specific guidelines for review and resubmission related to State review standards. Issuers must meet all applicable obligations under State and Federal law to be certified for sale on the beWellnm Platform.

NMHIX and OSI will make final certification decisions, and load certified plans on the beWellnm Platform for consumer purchase. NMHIX will provide all of their recommendations and relevant information to issuers in a timely manner and no later than the final plan recommendation deadline noted in Table 1.

Section 6. Plan ID Crosswalk

Pursuant to 45 CFR 155.335(j), Plan ID Crosswalk templates must be submitted to OSI as part of the SERFF Binder submission. Plan ID Crosswalk changes must be uploaded to SERFF.

Section 7. SERFF Template

BeWellnm will use the CMS templates for Plan Year 2022. Carriers should note that CMS made several changes in the templates during plan year 2021.

Section 8. Issuer Participation for the Full Plan Year

Issuers seeking QHP certification for individual and group plans must adhere to 45 CFR 156.272 in offering a plan through the entire plan year. This requirement also applies to SADPs offered in conjunction with QHPs. The full plan year for plan year 2022 is defined as 1/1/2022-12/31/2022.

CHAPTER 2: Stand Alone Dental Plans: 2022 APPROACH

CHAPTER 3: Qualified Health Plan and Stand-Alone Dental Plan Standards

Similar to the QHP certification process in past years, OSI will conduct reviews of QHPs and SADPs and provide to CMS and beWellnm the determinations on individual and small group QHPs and SADPs.
