Why Offer Health Insurance to Your Employees

Before enrolling in small group health insurance, many employers want to know: Will the benefits outweigh the costs?

Here are four reasons to offer coverage through beWellnm for Small Business:

Open Enrollment is Underway for Individuals and Families

What's New for 2022?

- BeWellnm has transitioned from the federal marketplace to a fully state-operated exchange.
- **This means enrollment for 2022 will take place through beWellnm.com, instead of at a federal website.**
- New Mexicans have until January 15 to enroll. That's one month longer than in prior years. Eligible residents who enroll by December 23 will receive coverage starting January 1, 2022. Eligible residents who enroll by January 15 will receive coverage starting February 1, 2022.
- For the first time, the Customer Engagement Center at 833.862.3935 is staffed by New Mexicans.
- BeWellnm now has six insurance carriers – the most in a single year since the organization's inception! This means greater choice and flexibility for your small business and your employees. Participating providers are Ambetter (from Western Sky Community Care); Blue Cross and Blue Shield of New Mexico; Friday Health Plans; Molina; Presbyterian Health Plan; and True Health New Mexico.



FAQs for Individual and Family Coverage

What is Open Enrollment?

This is the annual window of opportunity for eligible New Mexicans to sign up through the Marketplace to receive health care insurance at



little or no cost. In fact, four out of five state residents who are eligible for the exchange qualify for a plan for about \$10 or less. It is also an opportunity for those already enrolled to reevaluate their plan and make changes to existing coverage to make sure they are receiving the most appropriate and comprehensive health care coverage for their unique needs.

Why is it important?

- **Optimized health support:** The open enrollment period provides an opportunity for your small business and your employees to understand all your options; determine what financial assistance is available; and get support from certified brokers, at no cost.
- **Cost savings:** Many New Mexicans who have not previously qualified for health insurance through beWellnm may now be eligible, and those who have qualified in years past may now qualify for even greater financial assistance from the American Rescue Act.
- **Community wellness:** When more New Mexicans have health insurance, all of us are healthier. Fewer than half of the 95,000 residents eligible for coverage through beWellnm are enrolled.
