New Special Enrollment Period Launched

Help Available for Residents at Lower End of Income Scale

BeWellnm has launched a new special enrollment period (SEP) that provides qualified New Mexicans an opportunity to enroll in coverage. The new SEP enables state residents with **household incomes below 200%** of the federal poverty level and who aren't eligible for Medicaid or the Children's Health Insurance Program to enroll in a health insurance plan through beWellnm at any time of the year. Loss of Parent's Plan Doesn't Have to Mean Loss of Coverage

Young adults who have not yet turned 26 and who lose health care



insurance through a parent's plan need not worry. This is a significant life event that qualifies them to enroll in a beWellnm plan at any time via a [Special Enrollment Period](#), too.

However, they may not be aware of their options. You can help by sharing the below information with your network, family, and friends.

Two alternatives are available to

adults younger than 26:

- 1) If the individual is employed by a company that offers a job-based health plan but is not yet enrolled, the individual should contact their human resources representative before turning 26 to learn next steps.
- 2) They may enroll within 60 days of loss of coverage in their own individual health insurance plan through beWellnm. Before applying for coverage, they can see health and/or dental plans and prices available in their area [here](#).

Turning 26 this year? Immediate action required

Young adults who have health insurance under a parent's plan and are turning 26 this year need to take immediate action. If they do not take action before their 26th birthday, they have 60 days to do so beyond that date, or risk winding up with no health coverage.
